Originally made for life under canvas, these portable and space-saving pieces are now experiencing a resurgence of interest among city-dwellers with the launch of a new line by architect Campion Platt. Fascinated 'by the elegance of the historical designs', Platt has created a collection of 21 pieces, including a writing desk that packs neatly into its own case, and this series of multifunctional ebony wood boxes designed to be used as 'pull-up tables, for storage, display or for seating' (from \$500 each).
