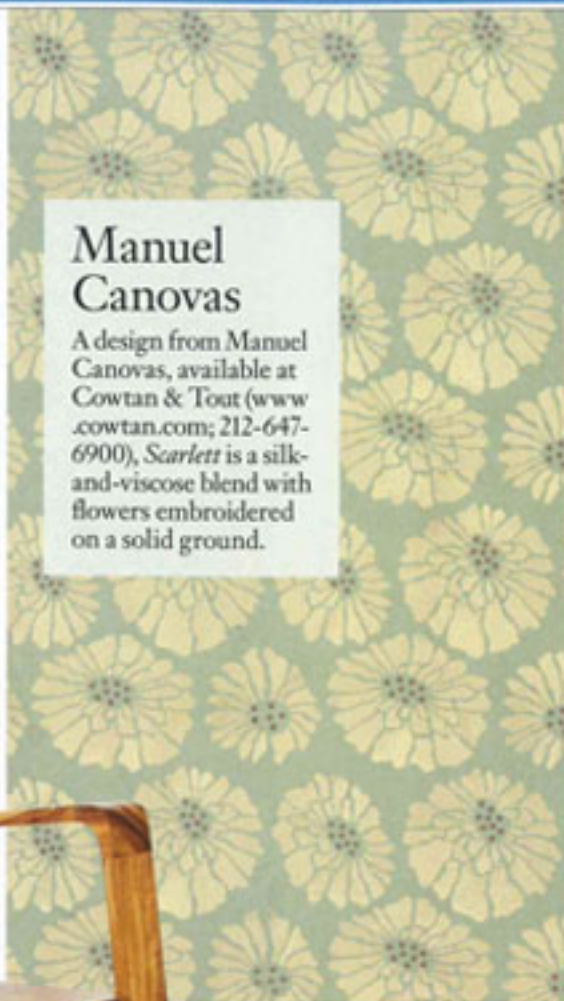
Island Life
